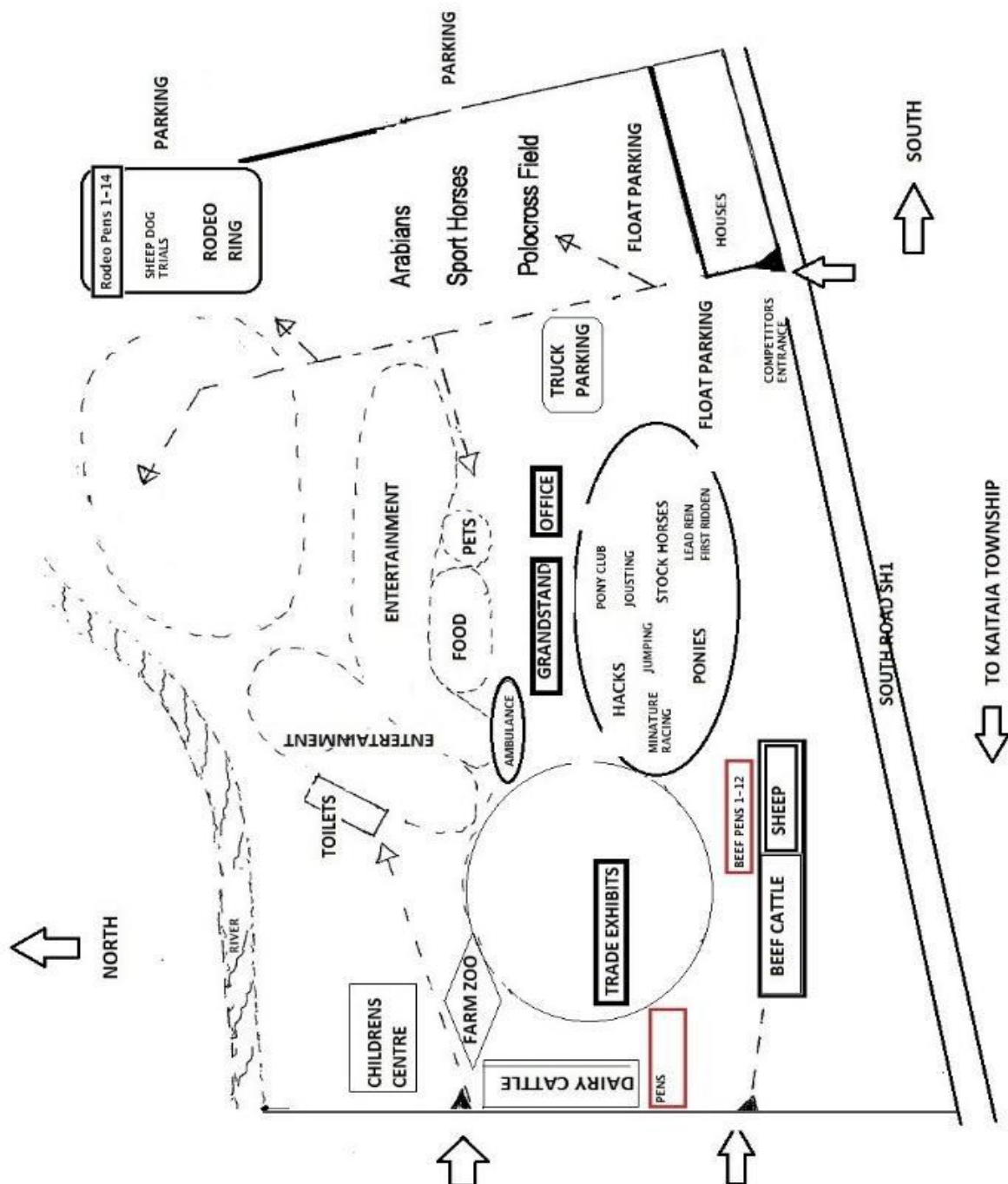

## **DAIRY and BEEF CATTLE RULES REGARDING TB REGULATIONS**

For animals from herds which are under movement restrictions imposed by and Official Directive or Restricted Place Notice by the Animal Health Board – the owner will have to satisfy the requirements of the Movement Control Notice before animals can move off the property to the Show. Provided these requirements are met, the AHB cannot prevent these animals from being shown. However, A & P Associations may choose not to accept such animals in the interests of other exhibitors. The RAS & the AHB strongly recommended A & P Associations do not accept such animals.

- For animals from Declared Movement Control Areas – all animals over the age of 90 days are to be tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the show.
- For animals from C10 status herds in Surveillance Areas (e.g. Northland)

No test is required but a clearly dated test allocation form or other documentation from the AHB must be submitted that shows the herd is not overdue for a whole herd test.

- For animals from all other areas – if the herd has a C3 status or better, no test is required PROVIDED the whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show, a) if the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the show, then show cattle over one year MUST have a clear test within the current show season. b) If the herd has a status of C1 or C2, then show cattle over 1 year old MUST have clear test within the current show season.

## Northern District RAS • Young Parader 2018-2019

Competition for Dairy and Beef Sections

**The aim of this competition is to encourage young people to enhance their skills on animal handling and knowledge whilst fostering showmanship between competitors as we as having an opportunity to bridge the gap between calf club and the pedigree ring**

- This competition is run in the Northern District only and the overall top four placings will be selected from participants who live within the Northern Districts RAS region.
- Competitors in the Junior competition are to be aged 5 – 12 (inclusive), whilst competitors in the Senior competition are to be aged 13 -19 (inclusive). All ages are as of October 1<sup>st</sup> of the current show season. Competitors may be asked for proof of age on show day.
- Entry is to be free for all competitors
- In the both the dairy and beef competitions, junior competitors may only enter a calf and senior competitors may enter either a calf or yearling only
- The competitor may only enter the beef or dairy class – not both. Any competitor recorded competing in both the dairy and beef section will be excluded from the overall competition
- To be eligible for the overall Northern District Young Parader prize, the competitor must complete in four or more Northern District A & P shows in the particular class for the current Show season.
- The competitor may enter as many shows as they wish, however their final score will be calculated as an average from their top four shows.
- The highest scoring Northern District competitors in each of the four classes will receive \$100 for 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$75 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, \$50 for 3<sup>rd</sup> and \$25 for 4<sup>th</sup> place, sponsored by the Northern District RAS.
- Judges are to line-up all competitors. Shows are to record the names of all entrants regardless of placing

Results will be published on the Northern Districts RAS Youth Facebook page shortly after each show in order to track the competition. Please contact this page directly with any queries.

Points are to be awarded as follows (regardless of number of competitors in the class)

1<sup>st</sup> = 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4, 4<sup>th</sup> = 3, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1

### Judging Guidelines

#### Presentation of the competitor

- The competitor will wear a plain white shirt with dark pants and clean, strong, appropriate boots for cattle handling. No open footwear or gumboots are permitted.
- No logos or advertising, including stud names to be present on any clothing including hats

#### Presentation of Animal

- The animal itself is not judged however the general presentation is taken into consideration as the youth will have prepared the animal for the ring.
- Rope, leather, chain and nylon halters are permitted. It should be clean and fit the animal correctly
- For beef competitors if a show stick is carried it must be carried correctly.

#### Parading of the animal

- The competitor should aim to display the animal in such a manner that the judge gains a clear view of the animal at all times and that the animal is seen to the best of its ability.
- Emphasis is placed on the effort of the competitor to be able to parade and handle in general regardless of the particular animal on the end of the halter, therefore senior competitors will be requested to swap animals (juniors will not)
- The competitor should be able to stop, move the animal on and keep under control whilst being aware of where the judge is in the ring
- **Outside assistance is not permitted under any circumstances and competitors will be disqualified**

## BEEF & FAT STOCK

- Prize money may be substituted by products
  - Classes for ANY DISTINCT BREED must be stated on the entry form
  - Three or less entries in class, No Prize Money, Ribbons only
  - First prize bull in any breed, judge for Champion and Reserve
  - First prize female in any breed, judged for Champion and Reserve
  - Unregistered section NOT eligible for Championship ribbons
  - The age of junior yearlings is to be computed on or after June 1. All beef bulls 2 years and over must be ringed and led. All bulls must be securely tied in the stalls by an adequate halter as well as a leather collar or chain.
- All pedigree cattle one year and over must be registered with the Breed Society

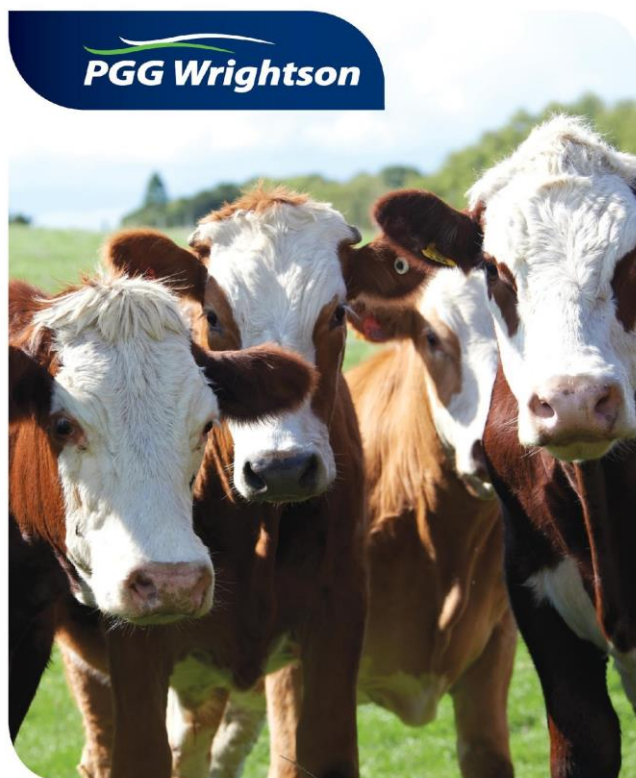

# MYCOPLASMA BOVIS



## Minimising the risks at shows and events

*Mycoplasma bovis* is a bacterial disease that only affects cattle. The main way *Mycoplasma bovis* spreads is through close and prolonged contact between cattle; and calves drinking milk from infected cows.

The risk of *Mycoplasma bovis* spreading at A&P shows, calf days, rodeo and other events where cattle are present is quite low, but there is still a risk wherever cattle may mingle.

Event organisers need to take these risks into account and manage mitigations when deciding if to hold their event while *Mycoplasma bovis* is being eradicated in New Zealand.

Animals on known infected farms are under movement control, and cannot be moved without MPI's permission. However, through efforts to eradicate this disease we are still tracing movements of animals, and we expect there are some we haven't reached and tested. So, it's important you take extra precautions to reduce your chances of spreading *Mycoplasma bovis*.

### What can exhibitors do?

- Animals on properties under any suspicion of exposure to *Mycoplasma bovis* should not be transported to shows and events.
- Animals showing clinical signs of **ANY** disease should not be transported to shows, as per normal biosecurity practice.
- Make sure your cattle are tagged and registered with NAIT.
- Keep your NAIT movements up-to-date and accurate and record movements to and from the event. Guidance is available on [nait.co.nz](http://nait.co.nz)
- Practice good on-farm biosecurity and clean and disinfect outerwear, boots and equipment before attending a show or event. On your return, clean and disinfect again before taking outerwear, boots and equipment back onto your farm. ### What can show and event organisers do?

- Ensure that exhibitors and participants are aware of your biosecurity and hygiene recommendations and their NAIT obligations.
- Animals without a NAIT tag should be denied entry and non-compliance reported to MPI.
- Ensure stalls are cleaned out before you put cattle in them, and after cattle are removed. Where possible, don't use the same stalls for cattle belonging to different exhibitors.
- Provide hand sanitiser for anyone likely to be handling the heads of animals from different owners.
- Any milking equipment used at the show should be cleaned and disinfected between uses on animals from different exhibitors.
- Give animals individual water – do not allow animals to drink from shared troughs.
- Best practice is to separate animals of the same species where possible, to prevent the spread of any disease. This can be by separating animals with walkways, using empty pens, and using outriggers or double barriers where animals are in adjacent pens.
- Don't keep animals in show pens for long, to reduce stress and nose-to-nose contact.
- Keep animals from different herds separate and avoid their nose-to-nose contact.
- Ensure pens are secure, and that when animals are out they are tethered or being securely managed by somebody who is strong and skilled enough (this could mean supervising children with calves).
- At rodeos when cattle are using the chute, disinfect all surfaces between each use with approved agricultural disinfectant, mixed as per manufacturer instructions.
